INTRODUCED FEBRUARY 13, 1986

By Assemblyman BENNETT and Assemblywoman MUHLER

AN ACT creating the position of vice-chairman of the Tidelands
Resource Council and amending P. L. 1948, c. 448.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 10 of P. L. 1948, c. 448 (C. 13:1B-10) is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 10. There shall be within the [Division of Resource Develop-
4 ment] *Department of Environmental Protection*, a [Resource De-
5 velopment] *Tidelands Resource Council* which shall consist of 12
6 members. Each member of the council shall be appointed by the
7 Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate, for a term of
8 four years and shall serve until his successor has been appointed
9 and has qualified, except that of the first appointments hereunder,
10 three shall be for a term of one year, three for two years, three for
11 three years and three for four years.

12 Each Governor shall designate one of the members of the council
13 as chairman *and one of the members as vice-chairman* of such
14 council. Any member of the council so designated shall serve as
15 such chairman *or vice-chairman* at the pleasure of the Governor
16 designating him and until his successor has been designated. The
17 chairman of the council shall be its presiding officer *and the vice-*
18 *chairman shall act as chairman in the chairman's absence.*

19 Any vacancies in the membership of said council occurring other
20 than by expiration of term shall be filled by the Governor, with the
21 advice and consent of the Senate, for the unexpired term only. Any
22 member of the council may be removed from office by the Governor,
23 for cause, upon notice and opportunity to be heard.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill
is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
Matter printed in italics thus is new matter.

24 The members of the council shall serve without compensation but
25 shall be reimbursed for necessary expenses incurred in the perfor-
26 mance of their duties.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

The Assembly Energy and Natural Resources Committee reported favorably Assembly Bill Number 2011. The bill also reflects the changed name of the Council as established in other provisions of law.
