1986 Assembly No. 1740

AN ACT concerning the membership of the Criminal Disposition Commission and amending N. J. S. 2C:48-1.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. N. J. S. 2C:48-1 is amended to read as follows:

2 2C:48-1. Composition. There is hereby created a Criminal Dis-  
3 position Commission, consisting of **[11]** *12* members consisting of  
4 two members of the Senate, no more than one of whom shall be of  
5 the same political party, appointed by the President of the Senate;  
6 two members of the General Assembly, no more than one of whom  
7 shall be of the same political party, appointed by the Speaker of the  
8 General Assembly; the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court or his  
9 designee, the Attorney General or his designee, the Public Advocate  
10 or his designee, the Chairman of the State Parole Board or his  
11 designee, the Commissioner of the Department of Corrections or  
12 his designee, *the President of the New Jersey Prosecutors Associa-*  
13 *tion or his designee* and two public members to be appointed by the  
14 Governor. The **[legislature]** *legislative* members shall serve for  
15 terms coextensive with their respective terms as a member of the  
16 House of the Legislature from which they are appointed and the  
17 two public members shall serve for a term of three years except  
18 that one of the initial appointments shall be for a term of one year.  
19 Members shall be eligible for reappointment to the commission.  
20 and vacancies in the commission shall be filled in the same manner  
21 as the original appointment, but for the unexpired term only. The  
22 members of the commission shall serve without compensation, but

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23 shall only be reimbursed for necessary expenses actually incurred  
24 in the performance of their duties under this chapter. The com-
