The procedure to effect the recall of an incumbent of the office of commissioner shall be as 4 follows: 5 A recall petition signed by at least twenty-five per centum (25%) 6 of the [qualified electors of any municipality as evidenced by the 7 total number of votes cast at the then next preceding general elec-8 tion for all of the members of the general assembly in such regis-9 tered voters of the municipality, shall be filed by the agent or agents 10designated in the petition with the municipal clerk, demanding the 11 recall of the commissioner sought to be removed. STATEMENT

This bill makes the law concerning recall elections under the commission form of government uniform with the recall election provisions in municipal manager municipalities and Faulkner Act municipalities. All three forms of government will now require that a recall petition be signed by at least 25% of the registered voters in order to be valid.
