4 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
5 of New Jersey:

7 1. Section 3 of P.L.1999, c.337 (C.18A:17-51) is amended to  
8 read as follows:

9 3. A board of education shall require any applicant for a  
10 permanent position as a buildings and grounds supervisor to provide  
11 documentation that he is a certified educational facilities manager  
12 who has received an authorization from the Department of  
13 Education pursuant to section 2 of P.L. , c. (C. ) (pending  
14 before the Legislature as this bill).

15 (cf: P.L.1999, c.337, s.3)

17 2. (New section) a. The Department of Education shall issue an  
18 authorization to serve as an educational facilities manager to an  
19 applicant who meets the criteria of a certified educational facilities  
20 manager as set forth in section 1 of P.L.1999, c.337 (C.18A:17-49).  
21 The department shall place the applicant on a master list of certified  
22 educational facilities managers to be maintained by the department.  
23 An authorization shall be valid for a period of three years from the  
24 date of issuance.

25 b. The department shall renew the authorization of a certified  
26 educational facilities manager upon receipt and verification of a  
27 renewal application submitted pursuant to section 3 of  
28 P.L. , c. (C. ) (pending before the Legislature as this bill).

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30 3. (New section) a. A certified educational facilities manager  
31 shall apply to the Department of Education for renewal of the  
32 authorization issued pursuant to section 2 of P.L. , c. (C. )  
33 (pending before the Legislature as this bill). The renewal  
34 application shall include a certified statement, upon a form  
35 prescribed by the department, that the applicant completed at least  
36 20 hours of training or continuing education in the prior three years  
37 in fields of study related to school facilities in the State and  
38 approved by the department.

This bill provides specific statutory authorization for that process and also requires a certified educational facilities manager to apply for renewal of the authorization every three years. The bill requires that the application include a certified statement that the applicant has completed at least 20 hours of training or continuing education in the last three years in fields of study related to school facilities in the State and approved by the department. In the case of an authorization issued by the department more than three years prior to the bill's effective date, the bill requires the department to establish a schedule for the submission of renewal applications for those authorizations.
