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STATEMENT

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This bill would dissolve the New Jersey Hall of Fame Advisory Commission and the New Jersey Hall of Fame corporation on the first day of the third month after enactment of this bill and transfer their property, funds, assets, and duties to the Foundation for the New Jersey Hall of Fame.

The corporation is a nonprofit entity created by the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority to operate and manage a New Jersey Hall of Fame. The hall of fame honors past and present individuals from the State, who have made substantial contributions to society through their accomplishments in the visual and performing arts, music, literature, science, education, sports, entertainment, business, religion, government, military, and philanthropy. The commission advises NJSEA with respect to the operation and management of the hall of fame, the development of new structures or the use of existing structures within which a hall of fame may be located, the criteria for selection of nominees to the hall of fame, the annual induction ceremonies for inductees to the hall of fame, and other programs and activities connected to the fund-raising activities of the foundation. The foundation sponsors fund-raising activities, solicits contributions, and determines the allocation of funds and contributions for the support of the hall of

The dynamic of having multiple organizations with overlapping responsibilities has led to instances of confusion and conflict in the administration of the hall of fame. This bill would streamline the management of the hall of fame by consolidating the property, funds, assets, and duties of the three organizations into one single

organization. This bill would provide the foundation with the flexibility and focus needed to effectively promote, fund, and operate the hall of fame.

Under the bill, the current members of the commission will continue to serve for one year following the effective date of the bill as members of the board of trustees of the foundation. After one year, membership on the board of trustees of the foundation will be governed by the foundation's bylaws.

Dissolves New Jersey Hall of Fame Advisory Commission and New Jersey Hall of Fame corporation and transfers their functions to Foundation for New Jersey Hall of Fame.
