INTRODUCED MARCH, 26 1962

By Senators DUMONT and WADDINGTON

Referred to Committee on Public Safety, Defense and Veterans Affairs

AN ACT providing immunity to members of volunteer first aid, rescue or emergency squads providing emergency public first aid and rescue services from liability to respond in damages in certain cases.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. No member of a volunteer first aid, rescue or emergency squad which
2 provides emergency public first aid and rescue services shall be liable in any
3 civil action to respond in damages as a result of his acts of commission or
4 omission arising out of and in the course of his rendering *in good faith* any
5 such services as such member *but such immunity from liability shall not ex-*
6 *tend to the operation of any motor vehicle in connection with such services.*

7 Nothing herein shall be deemed to grant any such immunity to any
8 person causing damage by his willful or wanton act of commission or
9 omission.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
