AN ACT to supplement "An act concerning school elections and supplementing Title 18 of the Revised Statutes and to repeal section 32 of 'An act concerning education prescribing certain offenses in connection with school elections and penalties for the commission thereof, and supplementing Title 18 of the Revised Statutes,' approved July 22, 1958 (P. L. 1958, c. 128)," approved May 27, 1963 (P. L. 1963, c. 58).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Any person violating any of the provisions of the act of which this
2 act is a supplement shall be ***[a disorderly person and shall be punished by**
3 **a fine not exceeding \$500.00 or by imprisonment not exceeding 1 year, or**
4 **both]*** **guilty of a misdemeanor*.*

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Any person violating any of the provisions of the act of which this
2 act is a supplement shall be a disorderly person and shall be punished by
3 a fine not exceeding \$500.00 or by imprisonment not exceeding 1 year, or
4 both.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to provide an appropriate punishment for violation of this portion of the school election laws, dealing with publication and distribution of circulars, handbills and similar material. The proposed legislation would remedy the inadvertent omission of a penalty, which occurred when the law was enacted.

ASSEMBLY COMMITTEE AMENDMENT TO

SENATE, No. 162

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

ADOPTED MAY 23, 1966

Amend page 1, section 1, lines 2 to 4, delete the words "a disorderly person and shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$500.00 or by imprisonment not exceeding 1 year, or both", and insert in lieu thereof "guilty of a misdemeanor".
