4 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the
5 State of New Jersey:

6 1. N.J.S. 18A:3-10 is amended to read as follows:

7 18A:3-10. The board of higher education shall hold public
8 meetings as it deems necessary to fulfill its duties and obligations
9 at such places within the state as it shall designate [at least once
10 each month at such times as its rules and regulations prescribe
11 and at such other times as in its judgment may be necessary] no
12 less than once each month for ten months per year.

The Senate Education Committee favorably reports this bill without committee amendments.
