STATE OF NEW JERSEY

INTRODUCED JANUARY 13, 1925.

By Mr. MACKAY.

Referred to Committee on Education.

AN ACT prohibiting discriminations on account of sex in the employment of teachers.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1 1. In the employment of teachers in any school, college, university or other edu-
2 cational institution in this State, which is supported, in whole or in part, by public
3 funds, or which is exempted from taxation, discriminations based on sex are pro-
4 hibited. This provision shall apply with reference to appointment, assignment, com-
5 pensation, promotion, transfer, resignation, dismissal and all other matters pertaining
6 to the employment of teachers. *Provided*, where any such school, college, university
7 or other educational institution is open only to members of one sex, nothing con-
8 tained herein shall be construed to prohibit the exclusive employment of teachers of
9 that sex.

1 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

ADOPTED MARCH 9, 1925.

AN ACT prohibiting discriminations on account of sex in the employment of teachers.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:*

1 1. In the formulation of a scale of wages for the employment of teachers in
2 any school, college, university or other educational institution in this State, which is
3 supported, in whole or in part, by public funds, there shall be no discrimination
4 based on sex, and the provisions of this act shall apply to appointment, assignment,
5 compensation, promotion, transfer, resignation, dismissal and all other matters per-
6 taining to the employment of teachers; *provided*, where any such school, college, uni-
7 versity or other educational institution is open only to members of one sex, nothing
8 contained herein shall be construed to prohibit the exclusive employment of teachers
9 of that sex.

1 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
