AN ACT providing for the regulation of traffic and parking upon certain county roads, and supplementing chapter 4 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Any municipality, which maintains a paid police force, may, with the
2 consent of the board of chosen freeholders of the county, by ordinance,
3 regulate traffic and parking along and upon any county road or part thereof,
4 lying within its corporate limits, in the same manner and to the same extent
5 that it is authorized by law to regulate the same upon municipal roads and
6 streets.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
