AN ACT concerning public reports.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1 1. In addition to his other duties, it shall be the duty of the State Librarian,
2 subject to the approval of the Governor, to critically examine, edit and prepare appro-
3 priate indices of all official reports presented by any official, institution, board, com-
4 mission or department of this State, and to determine what parts thereof, if any,
5 shall be printed, and the number of copies thereof to be printed.

1 2. No report of any official, institution, board, commission or department of
2 this State shall be printed except such as shall have been so examined and edited by
3 the State Librarian and shall have been approved by the Governor; *provided,*
4 *nevertheless,* that this section shall not apply to any report of any legislative com-
5 mittee or commission.

1 3. Hereafter, all reports required to be filed and not specified to be filed else-
2 where shall be filed with the Secretary of State.

1 4. Chapter two hundred and eleven of the Laws of one thousand nine hundred
2 and eight, being an act entitled "An act creating the department of public reports,"
3 approved April thirteenth, one thousand nine hundred and eight, and any and all
4 supplements thereto and amendments thereof, and section four of chapter four hun-
5 dred and thirty-three of the Laws of one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five,
6 being an act entitled "An act relative to public printing, stationery and blanks,"
7 approved June fifteenth, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five, and any and
8 all supplements to and amendments of said section four, and all acts and parts of

9 acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed, and this act shall take effect im-
10 mediately.

STATEMENT

This act abolishes the Department of Public Reports and transfers its functions to the State Librarian in accordance with the recommendations of the State Audit and Finance Commission.
