A recent management study of the State Highway Department recom-  
mended that an additional assistant State Highway Engineer be appointed to  
assist in the co-ordination and supervision of the wide range of technical activi-  
ties for which the State Highway Engineer is responsible.

FROM: Office of the Governor

Governor Richard J. Hughes today signed Assembly Bill No. 576, which revises the law concerning the Jersey City employees retirement system. This bill places the present system on an actuarially sound basis and will require additional contributions by both the City and the employees.

At the time of the signing the Governor stated:

"I am very pleased that the City and its employees have been able to work out a suitable proposal which will guarantee the financial solvency of the system thereby insuring the payment of the benefits to faithful employees when they retire. There are some provisions of this bill which provide for benefits somewhat out of line with other pension systems. Since this legislation, however, represents an overall revision and includes the requirement for additional contributions, I felt that I should approve it notwithstanding some discrepancy in benefits. There are several changes which should be made especially in the area relating to disability pensions. These amendments have been discussed with the sponsors and a bill to provide for the necessary changes will be introduced shortly."
