AN ACT to amend "An act concerning elections, and supplementing Title 19 of the Revised Statutes," approved March thirty-first, one thousand nine hundred and forty-five (P. L. 1945, c. 68).

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New
2 Jersey:

1 1. Section two of the act of which this act is amendatory is amended
2 to read as follows:

3 2. In counties of the second class having a population of four hundred
4 thousand or more where voting machines are used, [T] the county clerk shall
5 cause to be printed a sufficient number of official primary ballots and offi-
6 cial primary sample ballots of each political party, and sufficient stamped
7 envelopes for the mailing of such sample ballots in each election district
8 at the times and in the manner and number as required by the provisions
9 of Title 19 of the Revised Statutes, and shall furnish such official primary
10 sample ballots and envelopes to the municipal clerks on the earliest pos-
11 sible date preceding the primary election.

1 2. Section three of the act of which this act is amendatory is amended
2 to read as follows:

3 3. In counties of the second class having a population of four hundred
4 thousand or more where voting machines are used, [T] the cost of print-
5 ing of the official primary election ballots and primary election sample bal-

6 lots and stamped envelopes shall be paid by the county but the county shall
7 be reimbursed by the municipalities, each municipality paying such amount
8 as shall be apportioned to it by the county clerk based on the proportion
9 of the number of such official primary election ballots and primary election
10 sample ballots and stamped envelopes required for use in such municipality.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This act is necessary in order to make entirely clear that all the provisions
of P. L. 1945, chapter 68, apply only in counties of the second class having a
population of four hundred thousand or more where voting machines are used.
