AN ACT to amend "The Public Employees' Retirement-Social Security Integration Act," approved June 28, 1954 (P. L. 1954, c. 84).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 73 of the act of which this act is amendatory is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 73. a. The board of trustees of the Public Employees' Retirement System
4 is hereby authorized and directed to enroll in the Public Employees' Retire-
5 ment System employees of the New Jersey Turnpike Authority, the New
6 Jersey Highway Authority, Palisades Interstate Park Commission, Inter-
7 state Sanitation Commission, the Delaware River Basin Commission and the
8 Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission who consent and file applica-
9 tion for membership in said retirement system; those employees of such
10 agencies or instrumentalities who are members of the Public Employees'
11 Retirement System by virtue of section 7 of this act are not required to file
12 application for membership in said retirement system.

13 In the case of the Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission, the
14 employees shall be only those who are employed on the free bridges across
15 the Delaware river, under the control of said commission.

16 Upon such enrollment, the said employees shall be subject to the same
17 contribution and benefit provisions of the retirement system as State em-
18 ployees.

19 b. The State University of New Jersey, as an instrumentality of the
20 State, shall, for all purposes of this act, be deemed an employer and its
21 employees, both veterans and nonveterans, shall be subject to the same
22 membership, contribution and benefit provisions of the retirement system and
23 to the provisions of chapter 3 of Title 43 of the Revised Statutes as are
24 applicable to State employees and for all purposes of this act employment by
25 the State University of New Jersey after April 16, 1945, and for the pur-
26 poses of chapter 3 of Title 43 of the Revised Statutes any new employment
27 after the effective date of this amendatory act, shall be deemed to be and
28 shall be construed as service to and employment by the State of New Jersey.

29 c. *The Compensation Rating and Inspection Bureau, created and estab-*
30 *lished pursuant to the provisions of Revised Statutes 34:15-89, shall, for all*
31 *purposes of this act, be deemed an employer and its employees, both veterans*
32 *and nonveterans, shall be subject to the same membership, contribution and*
33 *benefit provisions of the retirement system and to the provisions of chapter 3*
34 *of Title 43 of the Revised Statutes as both are applicable to State employees.*

35 *The board of trustees shall certify to the Commissioner of Banking and*
36 *Insurance and the Commissioner of Banking and Insurance shall direct the*
37 *Compensation Rating and Inspection Bureau to provide the necessary pay-*
38 *ments to the retirement system in accordance with procedures established*
39 *by the board. Such payments shall include (1) the contributions and charges,*
40 *similar to those paid by other public agency employers, to be paid by the*
41 *Compensation Rating and Inspection Bureau to the retirement system on*
42 *behalf of its employee members, and (2) the contributions to be paid by the*
43 *Compensation Rating and Inspection Bureau to provide the past service*
44 *credits up to June 30, 1965 for these members, both veterans and nonvet-*
45 *erans, who enroll within 1 year after the effective date of this subsection.*

1 2. This act shall take effect June 30, 1965.
