- 1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*
- 3 1. Whenever any person holding employment, whose compen-  
4 sation is paid by this State or by any county, municipality or board  
5 of education in this State, or by any board, body, agency or com-  
6 mission thereof shall indicate in writing to the proper disbursing  
7 officer his desire to have any deductions made from his compen-  
8 sation, for the purpose of paying the employee's dues to a bona  
9 fide employee organization, designated by the employee in such  
10 request, and of which said employee is a member, such disbursing  
11 officer shall make such deduction from the compensation of such  
12 person and such disbursing officer shall transmit the sum so  
13 deducted to the employee organization designated by the employee  
14 in such request.
- 15 Any such written authorization may be withdrawn by such per-  
16 son holding employment at any time by the filing of notice of such  
17 withdrawal with the above-mentioned disbursing officer.
- 18 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
