AN ACT requiring seat safety belts on certain passenger automobiles and supple-
menting chapter 3 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. No person shall sell or operate any passenger automobile manu-
2 factured after July 1, 1966, and registered in this State unless such passenger
3 automobile is equipped with at least 2 sets of seat safety belts for the front seat
4 of the passenger automobile and the anchorage units necessary for their
5 attachment. Such seat safety belts and anchorage units shall be of a type
6 approved by the Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles in the Department
7 of Law and Public Safety, and in making any such approval the director shall
8 be guided by the specifications of the Society of Automotive Engineers.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
