STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: DECEMBER 18, 1989

The Senate Revenue, Finance and Appropriations Committee favorably reports Assembly Bill No. 5095, with committee amendments.

Assembly Bill No. 5095, as amended, increases the annual salary of the Governor from \$85,000 to \$130,000, beginning January 1, 1991. The present salary was established in statute in 1982.

This bill, as amended, is identical to Senate Bill No. 3983, as amended.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

The Committee amendments remove the condition that this bill cannot take effect until the enactment of three other bills, Assembly Bills Nos. 5093, 5094 and 5096.

FISCAL IMPACT

This bill contains no appropriation. The bill increases the annual salary of the Governor by \$45,000, which represents the annual cost of the bill. Since the bill takes effect halfway through FY 1991, the increased cost will be \$22,500 for that year. The full annual cost will first be incurred in FY 1992.
