A SUPPLEMENT to "An act concerning certain deductions from the taxes against the real and personal property for citizens and residents of this State now or hereafter honorably discharged or released under honorable circumstances from active service in time of war in any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States; and for certain widows, during widowhood and while residents of this State, of certain citizens and residents of this State who had active duty in time of war in any such service, supplementing chapter 4 of Title 54 of the Revised Statutes, repealing chapter 184 of the laws of 1951," approved December 16, 1963 (P. L. 1963, c. 171).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. The deductions from the taxes against real and personal property of
2 certain veterans and widows authorized pursuant to the act to which this act
3 is a supplement are hereby authorized and made available to property of
4 citizens and residents of this State now or hereafter discharged or released
5 under honorable circumstances from active service, in any branch of the
6 Armed Forces of the United States, in the southeast Asia area of warlike
7 conditions at any time beginning January 1, 1961 and terminating on such
8 date as shall be determined by Proclamation of the President of the United
9 States or concurrent resolution of the United States Congress, and widows
10 of such persons as defined in the act to which this act is a supplement.

1 2. For the purposes of this act active service in the "southeast Asia area
2 of warlike conditions" means and includes any area in southeast Asia in
3 which armed conflict or warlike conditions exist as determined by the Presi-
4 dent and includes not only land based service in said area but also service
5 in said area with the United States Navy and Air Force regardless of where
6 the individual's ship or unit is based.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

Governor Richard J. Hughes has signed the following bill:

Senate No. 272 - which makes available to veterans who have served in the Viet Nam theatre or their widows the deductions from local real and personal property taxes which are extended to other war-time veterans. At the time of approving the bill, the Governor issued the following statement:

"I concur most heartily with the Legislature with regard to this legislation. Certainly all persons now serving in the Viet Nam area are entitled to all of the privileges and preferences which this State has extended to our veterans of other armed conflicts.

"My review of this bill indicates that it could stand revision with regard to several technical problems. I believe, however, that these problems can be remedied by subsequent legislation and that the benefits provided in this legislation should not be delayed.

"There are, of course, numerous other statutes relating to veterans' benefits which are not affected by this legislation. It is, therefore, my intention to review all of these statutes with the Legislature when it returns in November, so that a consistent approach can be taken with regard to the extension of veterans' benefits to persons who have served in Viet Nam."
