LEGISLATIVE HISTORY OF R.S. 22A:3-1

L. 1953, chapter 22 - S19 (Clapp).

S19, 1953 was a bill establishing the new Title 22A and introduced by Judge Clapp together with a number of other bills creating Title 2A and making all the necessary changes in the Revised Statutes of 1937.

The bill had no statement, it was not amended during passage. There are no hearings or discussions in the Judicial Conference.

The bill makes changes only in the designation of officers conforming to the new Court system. It does not change the rates.

The earlier statute was R.S. 22:3-1. The draft to the 1937 Revision does not comment.
