AN ACT to amend "An act to provide for exemption from taxation in certain cases, and supplementing chapter four of Title 54 of the Revised Statutes," approved July twenty-first, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight (P. L. 1948, c. 256).

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New
2 Jersey:

1 1. Section one of the act of which this act is amendatory is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 1. The dwelling house and the lot or curtilage whereon the same is
4 erected, of any citizen and resident of this State, now or hereafter honorably
5 discharged or released under honorable circumstances, from active service,
6 in time of war, in any branch of the armed forces who has been or shall be
7 declared by the United States Veterans Administration or its successors to
8 have a service-connected disability from paraplegia, osteochondritis result-
9 ing in permanent loss of the use of both legs, or permanent paralysis of
10 both legs and lower parts of the body resulting from traumatic injury to
11 the spinal cord, skeletal structure, or brain; or from total blindness; or from
12 the amputation of both arms or both legs, or both hands or both feet, or the
13 combination of a hand and a foot shall be exempt from taxation, on proper
14 claim made therefor, and such exemption shall be in addition to any other

15 exemption of such person's real and personal property which now is or here-
16 after shall be prescribed or allowed by the Constitution or by law but no
17 taxpayer shall be allowed more than one exemption under this act.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
