AN ACT to amend ***and supplement*** "An act concerning alcoholic beverages and supplementing Title 33 of the Revised Statutes," approved August 3, 1962 (P. L. 1962, c. 152).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 2 of the act of which this act is amendatory is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 2. The provisions of this act shall not apply to the acquisition of an
4 additional license or licenses or an interest therein, when such license is
5 issued to a person for use in connection with the operation of a hotel con-
6 taining at least 50 sleeping rooms, *or for use in connection with the operation*
7 *of a **[business in which 51% of the gross annual income is derived from***
8 *the sale and service of meals and prepared food] ***restaurant***, nor shall
9 the provisions of this act affect the right of any person to dispose of an
10 interest in a license or licenses by will or to the transfer of such an interest
11 by descent and distribution.*

12 **Any additional license acquired for use in connection with **[the sale***
13 *and service of meals and prepared food] ***a restaurant***, as herein au-
14 *thorized, shall be limited, however, to the sale of alcoholic beverage for con-*
15 *sumption on the licensed premises only.***

1 ****[2. This act shall take effect immediately.]****

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

2 **2. Section 7 of the act of which this act is amendatory is amended to
3 read as follows:

4 7. Any person violating any provision of this act or of any rule or regu-
5 lation issued pursuant to this act shall be punished by a fine of not less than
6 \$50.00 and not more than \$250.00 and [to the revocation of any license is-
7 sued in violation of this act, in accordance with section 33:1-31.1 of the Re-
8 vised Statutes] such person shall also be subject to the penalties and pro-
9 visions of chapter 1 of Title 33 which are applicable thereto by virtue of such
10 violation.**

1 **3. The Director of the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control may
2 adopt from time to time such rules and regulations as shall be necessary or
3 desirable to carry out the provisions of this act and of the act to which this act
4 is a supplement.**

1 **4. This act shall take effect immediately.**
