## CHAPTER 90

**AN ACT** concerning insulin manufacturer assistance programs and supplementing P.L.2003, c.280 (C.45:14-40 et seq.).

**BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:*

C.45:14-67.11 Display of notice concerning insulin manufacturer assistance programs, pharmacy practice site.

1. a. A pharmacy practice site shall:

(1) display, in a conspicuous manner on the website of the pharmacy, a notice concerning insulin manufacturer assistance programs, to be created by the Department of Health; and

(2) at the individual's request, provide a pamphlet concerning insulin manufacturer assistance programs, to be created by the department, to an individual purchasing a prescription for insulin and any individual requesting a pamphlet.

b. An insulin manufacturer offering an assistance program may inform the department of its intention to be included in the notices and pamphlets.

c. The department shall adopt rules and regulations pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), to effectuate the purposes of this act.

2. This act shall take effect on the first day of the twelfth month next following the date of enactment, except that the Commissioner of Health may take any anticipatory administrative action in advance as shall be necessary for the implementation of this act.

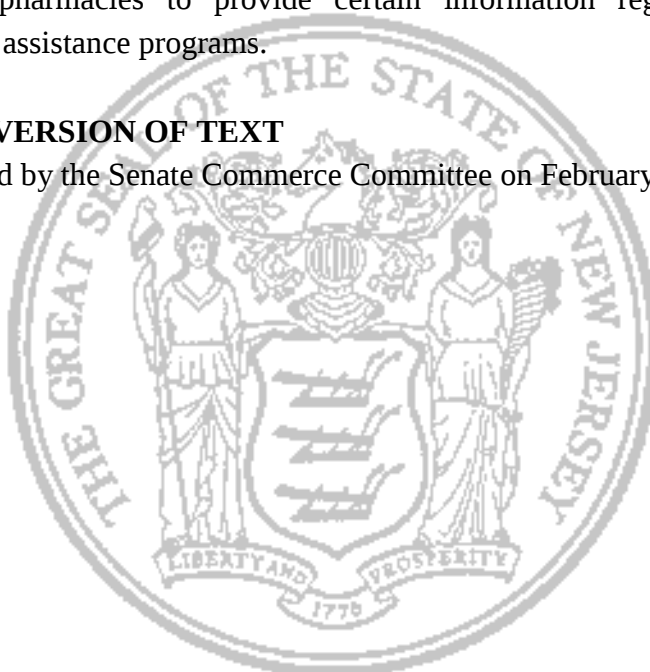

Under this bill, a pharmacy practice site will be required to display, in a conspicuous manner, a notice on its website, concerning insulin manufacturer assistance programs at all points of sale, the details of which are to be drafted by the Department of Health. A pharmacy practice site is also required to provide, upon the request of an individual, a pamphlet created by the department concerning insulin manufacturer assistance programs. Insulin manufacturers offering an assistance program may inform the department of their intention to be included in the notices and pamphlets. The effective date of the bill is twelve months from the date it is signed into law.

As reported by the committee, Senate Bill No. 2886 (1R) is identical to Assembly Bill No. 4015, which was also amended and reported by the committee on this date.

The Senate Commerce Committee reports favorably and with committee amendments Senate Bill No. 2886.

This bill requires pharmacies to provide certain information regarding insulin manufacturer assistance programs.

As amended, under this bill, a pharmacy practice site will be required to display, in a conspicuous manner, a notice on its website, concerning insulin manufacturer assistance programs at all points of sale, the details of which are to be drafted by the Department of Health. A pharmacy practice site is also required to provide, upon the request of an individual, a pamphlet created by the department concerning insulin manufacturer assistance programs. Insulin manufacturers offering an assistance program may inform the department of their intention to be included in the notices and pamphlets. The effective date of the bill is twelve months from the date it is signed into law.

#### COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:

The committee amended the bill to:

(1) require a pharmacy to display, in a conspicuous manner, information about insulin assistance programs on the website of the pharmacy and have the Department of Health draft the information to include on the website;

(2) make the distribution of pamphlets on insulin assistance programs by request of an individual to the pharmacy; and

(3) alter the effective date to twelve months from the date it is signed.

The Assembly Financial Institutions and Insurance Committee reports favorably and with committee amendments Assembly Bill No. 4015.

This bill requires pharmacies to provide certain information regarding insulin manufacturer assistance programs.

As amended, the bill requires a pharmacy practice site to display, in a conspicuous manner, a notice on its website concerning insulin manufacturer assistance programs, to be created by the Department of Health. A pharmacy practice site is also required to provide, at the request of an individual, a pamphlet created by the department concerning the insulin manufacturer assistance programs to any individual purchasing a prescription for insulin, or to any individual requesting a pamphlet. Insulin manufacturers offering an assistance program may inform the department of their intention to be included in the notices and pamphlets. The bill is to take effect twelve months from the date it is signed into law.

As amended and reported by the committee, Assembly Bill No. 4015 is identical to Senate Bill No. 2886 (1R), which was reported by the committee on this same date.

#### COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:

The committee amended the bill to:

(1) require a pharmacy to display, in a conspicuous manner, information about insulin assistance programs on the website of the pharmacy and have the Department of Health draft the information to include on the website;

(2) make the distribution of pamphlets on insulin assistance programs by request of an individual to the pharmacy; and

(3) alter the effective date to twelve months from the date it is signed.

# Governor Murphy Takes Action on Legislation

**TRENTON** – Today, Governor Murphy signed the following bills into law:

**S-1400/A-5448 (Singleton, Zwicker/Park, Freiman)** - “Uniform Partition of Heirs Property Act”; provides alternative process for handling partition actions filed in court concerning real property with multiple owners, at least one of whom had acquired title from relative

**S-1439/A-3856 (Singleton, A.M. Bucco/Sampson, McClellan, Miller)** - Requires health benefits coverage for additional orthotic and prosthetic appliances under certain circumstances; requires coverage for orthotic and prosthetic appliances obtained through podiatrists

**S-2886/A-4015 (Greenstein, Turner/McCoy)** - Requires pharmacies to provide certain information regarding insulin manufacturer assistance programs

**S-3787/A-5613 (Scutari, Ruiz/Pintor Marin, Morales)** - Requires municipal tax collectors who obtain payments in lieu of taxes under “Long Term Tax Exemption Law” to transmit county portion directly to county

**S-3850/A-5356 (Smith, Scutari/Karabinchak, Reynolds-Jackson)** - Permits county boards of elections to extend distance within which electioneering is prohibited

**S-3928/A-5322 (Ruiz, Scutari/Greenwald, Sampson)** - Limits general application of certain consumer contracts

**S-3961/A-5263 (Ruiz, Scutari/Haider, Morales, Karabinchak)** - Requires public and certain nonpublic schools to offer no-fee option to parents for making school lunch and other payments; requires payment processing platforms used by certain schools to provide users with information on user fees

**S-4162/A-5469 (Turner, Ruiz/Reynolds-Jackson, Carter, Morales)** - Limits use or disclosure of certain education records

**A-4113/S-2155 (Carter, Atkins/Cryan, McKeon)** - Prohibits sports wagering partnerships at public institutions of higher education

**A-5141/S-3813 (Peterpaul, Calabrese, Donlon/Gopal, O’Scanlon)** - Establishes historic distillery license; allows consumption of licensee’s products on and off licensed premises under certain circumstances

**A-5466/S-4318 (Bailey, Freiman, Reynolds-Jackson/Burzichelli, Greenstein)** - Requires BPU to study effects of data centers on electricity costs

**A-5736/S-4532 (Bailey, Simmons, Miller/Burzichelli, McKnight)** - Updates certain notification requirements in "Energy Bill Watch" program

## **Governor Signs Greenstein, Turner Bill to Providing Customers Info on Insulin Assistance Programs**

**TRENTON** – Governor Phil Murphy signed legislation sponsored by Senators Linda Greenstein and Shirley Turner that will require pharmacies to provide customers with information regarding insulin manufacturer assistance programs.

“Over the last decade, the cost of insulin has nearly doubled. To help people in New Jersey suffering from diabetes, we must do a better job promoting assistance programs that save them money on the out-of-pocket costs,” said Senator Greenstein (D-Mercer/Middlesex). “This legislation will ensure that more low-income individuals are aware that they may be eligible to receive their life-saving medication for a fraction of the retail cost.”



Under the law, S-2886, pharmacies will be required to display a notice concerning insulin manufacturer assistance programs on their website and provide a pamphlet concerning these programs upon request.

“Due to the high cost, many people ration their insulin or have had to choose between their medication and other necessities. Unfortunately, many of these individuals are eligible for assistance and have no idea,” said Senator Turner (D-Mercer/Hunterdon). “By displaying this information, more people will be aware of the existing assistance programs available to them.”

Insulin manufacturers’ assistance programs provide financial assistance or free insulin to people with diabetes who need it. These programs are often backed by drug companies, nonprofits, and medical institutions. The law will allow an insulin manufacturer offering an assistance program to inform the Department of Health of its intention to be included in the notices and pamphlets.

## McCoy Bill to Provide Insulin Aid Info at Pharmacies Signed into Law

*Legislation aims to increase awareness of cost-saving programs for diabetics*

(TRENTON) — Legislation (Bill [A4015](#)) sponsored by **Assemblywoman Tennille McCoy** requiring pharmacies to provide certain information on insulin manufacturer assistance programs was signed into law today.



“In the United States, insulin is seven to ten times more expensive than in any other country in the world,” **said Assemblywoman McCoy (D-Mercer and Middlesex)**. “Our goal is to ensure that residents are aware of the assistance that is available to help them obtain the insulin they need. When left untreated, diabetes can be fatal; when legislators craft legislation, we must do it with the needs of the most vulnerable people in our communities in mind.”

Under the bill, the Department of Health will create a notice regarding insulin manufacturer assistance programs that pharmacies will be required to display on their website. At the request of a customer, the pharmacy will provide a pamphlet about the insulin manufacturer assistance programs to anyone purchasing a prescription for insulin or to anyone who requests one.
