AN ACT concerning education, and amending section 18:7-67 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*  
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 18:7-67 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as fol-  
2 lows:

3 18:7-67. Every person presenting any bill, as provided in section 18:7-66  
4 of this Title, exceeding in amount the sum of \$5.00, shall **[make an affidavit]**  
5 *verify said bill by affidavit, include therein or annex thereto a signed dec-*  
6 *laration in writing* to the effect:

7 a. That the goods or services itemized in the bill have been delivered or  
8 rendered;

9 b. That no bonus or reward has been given or received by any person  
10 with the knowledge of the deponent in connection with the claim; and

11 c. That the bill is true and correct.

12 **[The district clerk may take the affidavit without cost.]**

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

## STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to eliminate the requirement of an affidavit upon any bill for goods or services rendered to Boards of Education in Article VII school districts; thus making the requirements for Article VII school districts the same as in Article VI districts, in municipalities, counties and the State of New Jersey.
