AN ACT relating to reproduction of the Great Seal, and supplementing chapter 2 of Title 52 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*  
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of the law, the Secretary of  
2 State is hereby authorized to give written consent to the use of reproduc-  
3 tions of the Great Seal of the State of New Jersey in the preparation of com-  
4 memcrative items and for historical, civic and educational purposes. The  
5 secretary shall promulgate rules and regulations governing the extent of  
6 each such usage to prevent inappropriate or misleading use of the Seal and  
7 to assure a high quality reproduction thereof. He shall require every ap-  
8 plication for such consent to be accompanied by such information and  
9 specifications as he shall deem necessary in order to assure compliance with  
10 his rules and regulations. Each application shall be accompanied by a  
11 \$10.00 filing fee and shall be valid for not longer than 1 year from the date  
12 of its issuance.

13 Any person who violates the provisions of this act or the rules and  
14 regulations promulgated by the secretary shall be liable to a penalty of  
15 \$50.00 for each violation. Such penalty shall be collected and enforced in a  
16 summary proceeding in accordance with the provisions of the penalty en-  
17 forcement law, N. J. S. 2A :58-1.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
