AN ACT regulating the practice of dentistry, requiring certificates for internes and residents, and amending section 45:6-20 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New  
2 Jersey:

1 1. Section 45:6-20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:  
2 45:6-20. Any person [who has made application to the board for a  
3 license to practice dentistry and who has been accepted by the board for  
4 examination] may practice dentistry as [a resident] an interne or resident  
5 in a public hospital or other public institution of this State for a period of  
6 one year [following such acceptance]; providing, such person shall furnish  
7 proof to the board that he can fulfill the requirements demanded in the other  
8 sections of this chapter relating to applicants for license to practice dentistry;  
9 but no such person shall be permitted to so engage in the practice of dentistry  
10 unless and until he obtains a certificate in writing from the board, which cer-  
11 tificate shall be at all times publicly exhibited in the public hospital or other  
12 public institution to which such person is attached as [a resident] an interne  
13 or resident. The board may, in its discretion, renew such certificate from  
14 year to year but not to exceed any aggregate of three years. The board shall  
15 charge and collect a fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) for each such certificate or

16 renewal thereof granted. Any public hospital or other public institution of  
17 this State, in order to avail itself of the provisions of this section and sec-  
18 tions 45:6-21 and 45:6-22 of this Title, shall first obtain a certificate in writ-  
19 ing from the board.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to permit an interneship or residency for a longer  
period than one which is now provided in the statute and provide a fee for the  
issuance of certificates.

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1 1. Section 45:6-20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

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5 in a public or private licensed hospital or other public or private institution  
6 of this State for a period of one year; *providing*, such person shall furnish  
7 proof to the board he can fulfill the requirements demanded in the other sec-

18 visions of this section and sections 45:6-21 and 45:6-22 of this Title, shall

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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12 or other public or private institution to which such person is attached as an  
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14 from year to year but not to exceed any aggregate of three years. The board  
15 shall charge and collect a fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) for each such certificate  
16 or renewal thereof granted. Any public or private licensed hospital or other  
17 public or private institution of this State, in order to avail itself of the pro-  
18 visions of this section and sections 45:6-21 and 45:6-22 of this Title, shall  
19 first obtain a certificate in writing from the board.

1 2. Section 45:6-21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as  
2 follows:

3 45:6-21. No dental interne or resident certified under section 45:6-20  
4 of this Title to any public or private licensed hospital or other public or  
5 private institution shall receive, collect or be entitled to, either directly or  
6 indirectly, any fees or compensation for any services rendered, while acting  
7 as such interne or resident; but nothing herein contained shall be con-  
8 strued to prevent or prohibit the public or private licensed hospital or other  
9 public or private institution to which any interne or resident is attached from  
10 providing compensation out of its funds for services so rendered by such in-  
11 terne or resident. The services rendered by any such interne or resident  
12 shall be strictly confined to the inmates and registered patients of the public  
13 or private licensed hospital or other public or private institution to which  
14 he is attached, and shall be performed under the supervision of a regularly  
15 licensed dentist of this State, who shall be a member of the staff of such  
16 hospital or institution. Every public or private licensed hospital or other  
17 public or private institution to which any such interne or resident is at-  
18 tached shall be subject to inspection by the board, or by its duly accredited  
19 inspectors or representatives.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
