INTRODUCED MARCH 16, 1945

AN ACT concerning the salaries of the holders of certain offices, positions and employments in the State service.

1     **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New  
2 Jersey:

1     1. In every case in which the amount of the salary to be paid to the  
2 holder of any office, position or employment in the State service is limited  
3 by a specific statutory maximum or a specific statutory minimum or a spe-  
4 cific statutory maximum and a specific statutory minimum, such maximum  
5 or minimum or such maximum and minimum hereby are abolished and abro-  
6 gated; *provided*, that the Civil Service Commission shall establish salary  
7 ranges for such office, position or employment, and thereafter the amount  
8 of such salary shall be fixed according to the salary ranges so established  
9 from time to time, except in any case in which the salary of any present  
10 holder of any such office, position or employment would be reduced thereby.

1     2. In every case in which specific statutory increases in the amount of  
2 any salary of the holder of any office, position or employment are provided,  
3 such specific statutory increases hereby are abolished and abrogated; *pro-*  
4 *vided*, the Civil Service Commission shall establish automatic increases in  
5 such salary, based upon length of service, within the salary ranges estab-  
6 lished from time to time therefor, and such salary shall thereafter auto-  
7 matically be increased accordingly, unless the head of the department and  
8 the Civil Service Commission shall agree that the service record of the

9 holder of such office, position or employment does not warrant any such in-  
10 crease in salary.

1 8. This act shall not apply to the head of any department or the head  
2 of any division or bureau of any department nor to any case in which the  
3 salary of any holder of any such office, position or employment is specifically  
4 fixed by any act of the Legislature.

1 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

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#### STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to comply with the recommendation made in the Governor's Budget Message and to substitute for statutory maximum and minimum limitations of salary, salary range classifications to be made by the Civil Service Commission, and to substitute for statutory increments of salary increases, increments to be set up by the Civil Service Commission.

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
