STATE OF NEW JERSEY

ADOPTED MAY 23, 1955

AN ACT concerning leaves of absence of certain public employees to attend State
or national conventions.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. The head of every public department and of every court of this State,
2 the heads of the county offices of the several counties and the head of every
3 department, bureau and office in the government of the various munici-
4 palities, shall give a leave of absence with pay to every person in the
5 service of the State, county or municipality who is a duly authorized
6 representative of the New Jersey State Patrolmen's Benevolent Association,
7 Inc., Fraternal Order of Police, Firemen's Mutual Benevolent Association,
8 Inc., and the Uniformed Firemen's Association, to attend any State or
9 national convention of such organization.

10 A certificate of attendance to the State convention shall, upon request,
11 be submitted by the representative so attending.

12 Leave of absence shall be for a period inclusive of the duration of the
13 convention with a reasonable time allowed for time to travel to and from the
14 convention.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

AN ACT concerning leave of absence from public employment, and amending
section 38:23-2 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 38:23-2 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
2 38:23-2. The head of every public department and of every court of this
3 State, every superintendent or foreman on the public works of this State,
4 the heads of the county offices of the several counties and the head of every
5 department, bureau and office in the government of the various municipali-
6 ties, shall give a leave of absence with pay to every person in the service of
7 the State, county or municipality who is a duly authorized representative of
8 the Grand Army of the Republic, United Spanish-American War Veterans,
9 Disabled American Veterans of the World War, Veterans of Foreign Wars,
10 Indian War Veterans, American Legion, Jewish War Veterans of the United
11 States, Catholic War Veterans of the United States, Women's Overseas
12 Service League, American Veterans World War II, Reserve Officers Asso-
13 ciation of the United States, Marine Corps League of the United States,
14 Army and Navy Legion of Valor, the Twenty-ninth Division Association,
15 *New Jersey State Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Inc.*, Council of State
16 Employees, War Veterans Public Employees Association, and the New Jer-

17 sey Civil Service Association, to attend any State or national convention of
18 such organization.

19 A certificate of attendance to the State convention or encampment shall,
20 upon request, be submitted by the representative so attending.

21 Leave of absence shall be for a period inclusive of the duration of the
22 convention with a reasonable time allowed for time to travel to and from the
23 convention.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
