AN Act concerning hunting of deer with a dog and amending section 23:4-46 of
the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 23:4-46 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
2 23:4-46. No person shall *at any time, or for any reason, hunt for, pursue,*
3 *track, trail, search for, seek, capture or kill* a wild deer with a dog.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

A recent court decision indicates clarification of the existing statute is necessary to eliminate the possibility of the use of dogs in hunting deer.
