AN ACT to amend "An act concerning the registration of certain motor vehicles in the State, and supplementing chapter 3, Title 39, of the Revised Statutes," approved April 12, 1948 (P. L. 1948, c. 28).

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New
2 Jersey:

1 1. Section 1 of the act of which this act is amendatory is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 1. No fee shall be charged for the registration, in any year or years,
4 of 1 motor vehicle of passenger type, which is not to be used for hire, owned
5 by any resident of the State of New Jersey;

6 (1) who is eligible for compensation pursuant to sections 38:18-1,
7 38:18-2 and 38:18-3 of the Revised Statutes or,

8 (2) who has qualified or shall qualify under the provisions of Public
9 Law 663—79th Congress of the United States of America (August 8, 1946)
10 or of Public Law 187—82nd Congress of the United States of America (Oc-
11 tober 20, 1951) or who is a veteran of World War I with service-connected
12 disabilities of the kind set forth in said Public Laws, and who is the holder
13 of a current driver's license issued by this State, if such motor vehicle is
14 equipped with such special attachments and devices as the Director of the
15 Division of Motor Vehicles in the Department of Law and Public Safety may
16 deem necessary to provide for the safe operation thereof by such person.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
