AN ACT concerning elections, and supplementing Title 19 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. In counties of the second class having a population of four hun-
2 dred thousand or more where voting machines are used, each mu-
3 nicipal clerk shall, on or before the eighth day following the last day for
4 the filing of petitions for the primary election in each year, certify to the
5 county clerk the full and correct names and addresses of all candidates for
6 nomination for public and party office, and the name of the political party of
7 which such persons are candidates, together with their slogan and designation,
8 and the order in which their names were drawn in accordance with the pro-
9 visions of Title 19 of the Revised Statutes.

1 2. The county clerk shall cause to be printed a sufficient number of official
2 primary ballots and official primary sample ballots of each political party,
3 and sufficient stamped envelopes for the mailing of such sample ballots in
4 each election district at the times and in the manner and number as required
5 by the provisions of Title 19 of the Revised Statutes, and shall furnish such
6 official primary sample ballots and envelopes to the municipal clerks on the
7 earliest possible date preceding the primary election.

1 3. The cost of printing of the official primary election ballots and primary
2 election sample ballots and stamped envelopes shall be paid by the county but
3 the county shall be reimbursed by the municipalities, each municipality pay-
4 ing such amount as shall be apportioned to it by the county clerk based on
5 the proportion of the number of such official primary election ballots and
6 primary election sample ballots and stamped envelopes required for use in
7 such municipality.

1 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
