AN ACT concerning education and supplementing Title 18A of the
New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. In any regional school district in which the annual or special
2 appropriations for regional purposes, exclusive of the amounts to
3 be raised for interest upon, and the redemption of, bonds payable
4 by the district, have heretofore been apportioned among the mu-
5 nicipalities included within the district on the basis of the number
6 of pupils enrolled, such apportionment shall be made as follows:

7 a. For the school year 1967-77, ****[75%]**** ****80%**** **on a per*
8 *pupil basis with respect to current operating costs and interest*
9 *upon and redemption of bonds** ****[on such basis]**** and
10 ****[25%]**** ****20%**** pursuant to N. J. S. 18A:13-23;

11 b. For the school year 1977-78, ****[50%]**** ****60%**** **on a per*
12 *pupil basis with respect to current operating costs and interest*
13 *upon and redemption of bonds** ****[on such basis]**** and
14 ****[50%]**** ****40%**** pursuant to N. J. S. 18A:13-23;

15 c. For the school year 1978-79, ****[25%]**** ****40%**** **on a per*
16 *pupil basis with respect to current operating costs and interest*
17 *upon and redemption of bonds** ****[on such basis]**** and
18 ****[75%]**** ****60%**** pursuant to N. J. S. 18A:13-23;

19 ****d.** *For the school year 1979-80, 20% on a per pupil basis with*
20 *respect to current operating costs and interest upon and redemp-*
21 *tion of bonds and 80% pursuant to N. J. S. 18A:13-23;*

22 ****[d.]**** ****e.**** For all school years thereafter, the apportion-
23 ment shall be made pursuant to N. J. S. 18A:13-23.

13 d. For all school years thereafter, the apportionment shall be
14 made pursuant to N. J. S. 18A:13-23.
1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

Many regional districts currently apportion their current expense costs among their constituent municipalities on a per pupil basis. The Public School Education Act of 1975 changes this basis of apportioning such costs. This change will drastically increase the tax rates in some constituent municipalities and lower it in others. It is the purpose of this bill to phase in the new method of apportioning such costs over a 3-year period.
