AN ACT to provide for the acceptance on behalf of the State and the administration for the State of grants, conveyances, devises, bequests, or donations, to be used for the purposes of any division or bureau established in the State Department of Education or, of any teachers' college, school or institution under the control of the Commissioner of Education and the State Board of Education, and supplementing article two of chapter three of Title 18 of the Revised Statutes.

1 *BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Subject to approval by the Governor and the State Board of Educa-
2 tion, the Commissioner of Education may accept on behalf of the State and
3 administer for the State any grant, conveyance, devise, bequest, or donation
4 to be applied, principal or income, or both, for the purposes specified in such
5 grant, conveyance, devise, bequest, or donation to the maintenance and use
6 of any service in, or activity of, any division or bureau established in the
7 State Department of Education, or of any teachers' college, school or in-
8 stitution of learning under the control of the Commissioner of Education
9 and the State Board of Education; except that any such grant, conveyance,
10 devise, bequest, or donation for the purposes of "The Division against Dis-
11 crimination" shall be approved by the Governor and the council of said
12 division and not by the State Board of Education.

1 2. Prior to the acceptance of any grant, conveyance, devise, bequest, or
2 donation mentioned in section one of this act, due notice and hearing, if re-
3 quested, shall be granted by the Commissioner of Education and the State
4 Board of Education to any municipality or municipalities which may be af-
5 fected thereby.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This act authorizes the commissioner to accept and administer any grant, conveyance, devise, bequest or donation to be used for the purposes of any of the divisions and bureaus established in the State Department of Education or any of the teachers' colleges, schools, or institutions under its control. The commissioner may not accept any grant, conveyance, etc., under this act without the approval of the State Board of Education and the Governor and without granting a hearing, if requested, to any municipality which may be affected thereby. The authority sought in this act is particularly needed for the furtherance of the work of the Division of the State Museum and the State Library, Archives and History and the State teachers' colleges.

1. **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. Subject to approval by the Governor and the State Board of Education, the Commissioner of Education may accept on behalf of the State and administer for the State any grant, conveyance, devise, bequest, or donation to be applied, principal or income, or both, for the purposes specified in such grant, conveyance, devise, bequest, or donation to the maintenance and use of any service in, or activity of, any division or bureau established in the State Department of Education, or of any teachers' college, school or institution of learning under the control of the Commissioner of Education and the State Board of Education; except that any such grant, conveyance, devise, bequest, or donation for the purposes of "The Division against Discrimination" shall be approved by the Governor and the council of said division and not by the State Board of Education.

1 2. Prior to the acceptance of any grant, conveyance, devise, bequest, or
2 donation mentioned in section one of this act, due notice and hearing, if re-
3 quested, shall be granted by the Commissioner of Education and the State
4 Board of Education to any municipality or municipalities which may be af-
5 fected thereby.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
