AN ACT concerning certain records of the Division of Workmen's Compensation,  
and supplementing chapter 15, Title 34 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*  
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of the chapter to which this act  
2 is a supplement or of any other law, no records maintained by the Division  
3 of Workmen's Compensation shall be open to inspection or copying by or on  
4 behalf of any person who seeks such inspection or copying for the purpose  
5 of selling or furnishing for a consideration to others reports or abstracts  
6 of workmen's compensation records or work-injury records pertaining to any  
7 individual, except in the case of an investigation by or on behalf of an  
8 employer in connection with any pending workmen's compensation case.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
