As amended, this bill revises current State law requiring certain student identification cards to contain the telephone number for a suicide prevention hotline.

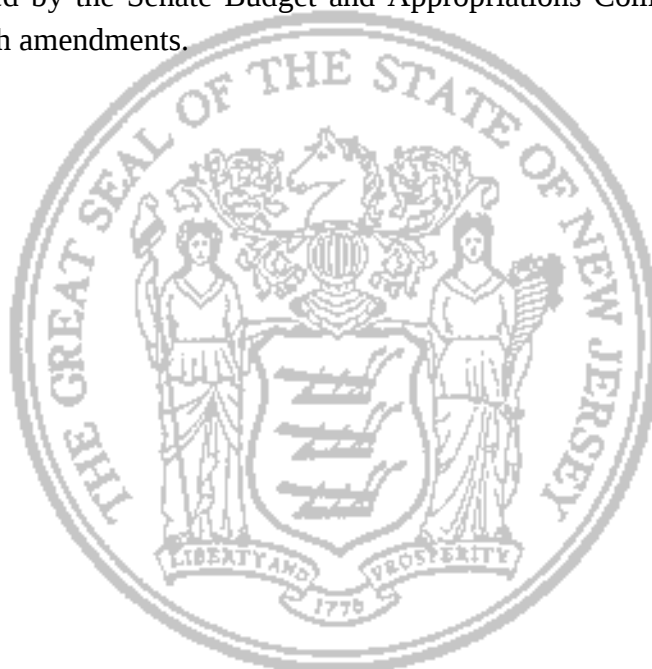

Governor Signs Amato Bill to Protect Students' Mental Health

Bipartisan legislation sponsored by Senator Carmen Amato, Jr. (R-9) and Senator Joseph Cryan (D-20) to ensure students are provided with contact information for critical mental health and suicide prevention resources has been signed into law.



“I want to sincerely thank Senator Cryan for his partnership, leadership, and unwavering dedication to the well-being of New Jersey’s youth. Youth suicide is a heartbreaking crisis, and we have a responsibility to do everything in our power as legislators to protect our students,” said Senator Amato. “This bill makes a small but powerful change to ensure that every student has access to trusted, potentially life-saving mental health support. For some, it may look like just a phone number; but for a young person in pain, it could be a lifeline.”

Governor Murphy signed the bill ([S-3769/A-4897](#)) into law on July 22, 2025.

Under previous law, public schools and colleges or universities were required to print the telephone number for the New Jersey Suicide Prevention Hopeline (NJ Hopeline) and contact information for a crisis text line on the back of each student identification card.

Senator Amato’s newly signed law revises that requirement to also include the telephone number for the national suicide prevention hotline, expanding access to vital resources for students across the state.
