AN ACT to change the name of the State Board of Registration and Examination in Dentistry and amending section 45:6-1 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New
2 Jersey:

1. Section 45:6-1 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

2 45:6-1. The State Board of Registration and Examination in Dentistry
3 in the Division of Professional Boards of the Department of Law and Public
4 Safety, hereinafter in this chapter designated as the "board," created and
5 established by an act entitled "An act to regulate the practice of dentistry
6 in the State of New Jersey, and to repeal certain acts now relating to the
7 same," approved March 31, 1915 (L. 1915, c. 146, p. 261), as amended and
8 supplemented, is continued [.] , and shall hereafter be known and desig-
9 nated as the New Jersey State Board of Dentistry. Wherever in any law,
10 rule, regulation, judicial or administrative proceeding or otherwise, refer-
11 ence is made to the State Board of Registration and Examination in Den-
12 tistry, the same shall mean and refer to the New Jersey State Board of
13 Dentistry.

14 The board shall consist of 8 members, each of whom shall have resided
15 and practiced dentistry in this State for at least 10 years immediately pre-
16 ceding his appointment. Upon the expiration of the term of office of any

17 member, his successor shall be appointed by the Governor, subject to the
 18 provisions of section 45:1-2 of this Title, for a term of 4 years, except that
 19 the successors of the members whose terms will expire on June 4, 1949, shall
 20 be appointed each for a term expiring on August 31, 1952; the successors
 21 of the members whose terms will expire on November 9, 1949, and January
 22 7, 1950, respectively, shall be appointed each for a term expiring on August
 23 31, 1953; the successors of the members whose terms will expire on July 31,
 24 1950, and October 8, 1950, respectively, shall be appointed each for a term
 25 expiring on August 31, 1954; and the successors of the members whose
 26 terms will expire on July 30, 1951, and November 4, 1951, respectively, shall
 27 be appointed each for a term expiring on August 31, 1955. Each member
 28 shall hold his office until his successor is appointed and qualifies. Any va-
 29 cancy in the membership of the board, occurring from any cause, shall be
 30 filled by the Governor for the unexpired term only. Upon cause being shown
 31 before him, the Governor may remove a member from office upon proven
 32 charges of inefficiency, incompetency, immorality or professional misconduct.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to change the name of the State Board of Reg-
 istration and Examination in Dentistry to the New Jersey State Board of
 Dentistry.
