AN ACT to amend "An act concerning the Board of Commerce and Navigation, and supplementing Title 12, chapter 6, of the Revised Statutes," approved May 1, 1940 (P. L. 1940, c. 52).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 1 of the act of which this act is amendatory is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 1. In addition to the powers conferred by the provisions of the act to
4 which this act is a supplement, the State Department of Conservation and
5 Economic Development is hereby authorized and empowered to repair, re-
6 construct, or construct bulkheads, seawalls, breakwaters, groins **[or]**, jetties,
7 beachfills **[or]**, dunes *and any or all appurtenant structures and work*, on
8 any and every **[beach]** *shore* front along the Atlantic ocean, in the State of
9 New Jersey, or any **[beach]** *shore* along the Delaware bay and Delaware
10 river, Raritan bay, Barnegat bay, **[and]** Sandy Hook bay, *Shrewsbury river*
11 *including Navesink river, Shark river, and the coastal inland waterways ex-*
12 *tending southerly from Manasquan Inlet to Cape May Harbor*, or at any inlet
13 **[or]**, *estuary or tributary waterway* or any inland **[waters]** *waterways ad-*
14 *jacent to any inlet [or], estuary or tributary waterway* along the shores of

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

16 erosion and storm, or to prevent erosion of the [beaches] *shores* and to

18 *essential to the execution of this authorization and the powers granted hereby.*

1 *2. Section 2 of chapter 104 of P. L. 1960 is hereby repealed.*

1 ***[2.]*** *3.* This act shall take effect immediately.
