## STATE OF NEW JERSEY

INTRODUCED JANUARY 16, 1928.

Referred to Committee on Municipal Corporations.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An act concerning municipalities," approved March twenty-seventh, nineteen hundred and seventeen.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1 1. Section three of Article XXIV of the act to which this act is an amend-  
2 ment be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 3. Nothing herein shall repeal or make void any statutory provision for the  
4 creation of lighting districts in townships, and the lighting of streets and public  
5 places in said districts, nor shall governing bodies in townships have power to make  
6 any contracts for lighting for a [longer] period not exceeding [than one year],  
7 five years except as now provided by law.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

### STATEMENT.

This law is not mandatory.

The law at the present time as applies to public lighting for townships only permits a contract to be made for a period of one year.

Because of the one-year period for public lighting by townships, townships cannot make as favorable contracts as if the period were for more than one year.

This law amends the Law of 1917, Chapter 152, page 410, Section 3, so that this law will permit townships to make public lighting contracts for a period not exceeding five years.
