AN ACT concerning Federal grants of funds and Federal grants and loans of equipment, supplies, materials and other property for war or defense purposes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. In order to facilitate co-operation with the United States of America
2 in carrying on war and defense activities, all boards, bodies, officers and
3 agencies of this State and of every county, municipality and school district
4 thereof, are authorized: (a) to accept from the United States of America or
5 any board, body, agency or independent establishment thereof, subject to the
6 terms and conditions appertaining thereto, grants of funds and grants and
7 loans of equipment, supplies, materials and other property; and (b) to hold,
8 use, expend, deal with, employ, distribute and dispose of such funds, equip-
9 ment, supplies, materials and other property; and (c) to engage in such
10 activities, to enter into such contracts and to do such other acts and things
11 as may be necessary or convenient to carry out the powers given by this act.

1 2. The powers conferred by this act shall be in addition and supple-
2 mental to the powers conferred by any other law, and shall not be subject
3 to any limitation contained in any other law nor shall the limitations of this
4 act affect the powers conferred by any other law.

1 3. This act shall be liberally construed to effectuate its purpose.

1 4. If any provision of this act, or the application of such provision to
2 any person, body or circumstance, shall be held invalid, the remainder of
3 this act, or the application of such provision to persons, bodies or circum-
4 stances other than those with respect to which it shall have been held invalid,
5 shall not be affected thereby.

1 5. The authority hereby conferred to accept grants and loans shall con-
2 tinue in effect so long as the United States of America continues in the
3 present wars with the governments of Japan, Germany and Italy, or any
4 of them, and until the making of a treaty or treaties of peace concluding
5 all of said wars.

1 6. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

The Council of State Governments has recommended the passage of this type of legislation in all the States in order to facilitate co-operation with the Federal government in our war efforts.

9 defined in section 48:2-13 of the Revised Statutes.

1 3. This act shall be liberally construed to effectuate its purpose.

2 any person, body or circumstance, shall be held invalid, the remainder of
3 this act, or the application of such provision to persons, bodies or circum-
4 stances other than those with respect to which it shall have been held invalid,
