An Act concerning motor vehicles and traffic regulation, and amending section 39:10-19 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New  
2 Jersey:

1 1. Section 39:10-19 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as fol-  
2 lows:

3 59:10-19. No person shall engage in the business of buying, selling or  
4 dealing in motor vehicles in this State, unless he is authorized to do so  
5 under the provisions of this chapter. The commissioner may, upon appli-  
6 cation in such form as he prescribes, license any proper person as such  
7 dealer. [The license shall be issued for the calendar year and a license  
8 fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be paid for the first year. It shall be  
9 renewed on the dealer's application from year to year thereafter without  
10 payment of a renewal fee.] A license fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be  
11 paid by the applicant for the initial license, which shall be renewed on the  
12 dealer's application from year to year thereafter without payment of a  
13 renewal fee. Every license shall expire on March thirty-first of each year  
14 terminating the period for which it is issued. On and after February first  
15 of each year the commissioner shall issue licenses for the following yearly  
16 period to expire on March thirty-first of the following year. Licenses which  
17 have been issued at the time of the passage of this amendment for the year

18 one thousand nine hundred and forty will expire on March thirty-first of  
19 the year one thousand nine hundred and forty-one.

1. 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

**STATEMENT**

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that the expiration date of licenses issued to dealers under the Bill of Sale Law shall expire on the same date as the motor vehicle registrations issued to the dealers. All motor vehicle registrations expire on March thirty-first of each year and the dealer's bill of sale license should also expire on the same date.
