STATEMENT

AN (1948)

The purpose of this bill is to change the language of the sections of the alcoholic beverage law which provide for municipal referenda in connection with the sale of certain alcoholic beverages so as to conform with the provisions of Article II, paragraph 1 of the new Constitution.

This bill was drafted by the Law Revision and Bill Drafting Commission under the direction of the Senate and General Assembly Committees on Law Revision.
