AN ACT assenting to the provisions of the Act of Congress entitled "An act to provide that the United States shall aid the States in wildlife-restoration projects, and for other purposes," approved September second, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. The State of New Jersey hereby assents to the provisions of the Act
2 of Congress entitled "An act to provide that the United States shall aid the
3 States in wildlife-restoration projects, and for other purposes," approved
4 September second, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven (Public, No.
5 415, 75th Congress), and the Board of Fish and Game Commissioners is
6 hereby authorized, empowered and directed to perform such acts as may be
7 necessary to the conduct and establishment of co-operative wildlife-restora-
8 tion projects, as defined in said Act of Congress, in compliance with said
9 Act and with rules and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of Agri-
10 culture thereunder.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

The above bill is necessary in order for the State of New Jersey to obtain the benefits under the act passed by Congress, which sole purpose is to assist

the States in carrying on a wider scope of game management and restoration program and appropriates to the State an amount of money based on the number of hunting licenses issued, the funds of the United States Government being derived from the tax on firearms and ammunition. The estimated amount of money annually for New Jersey is \$40,000, and unless this bill is passed by the present session of the Legislature, New Jersey will forfeit this appropriation from the Government.
