An Act concerning salaries of judges of the County Courts, and repealing section 2:6-16 of the Revised Statutes.

**1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New
2 Jersey:**

**1 1. The annual salary of each judge of a County Court, in and for a
2 county in which the Governor may appoint more than one judge of the County
3 Court, shall be sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000.00).**

**1 2. The annual salary of each judge of a County Court, in and for a
2 county in which the Governor may appoint only one judge of the County
3 Court, shall be:**

**4 (a) In counties having more than seventy-five thousand inhabitants, ten
5 thousand dollars (\$10,000.00).**

**6 (b) In counties having not more than seventy-five thousand inhabitants,
7 seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500.00).**

**1 3. The salaries of the judges of the several County Courts provided
2 herein shall be payable from county funds, by the treasurers of the respec-
3 tive counties, in equal semimonthly installments; provided, however, that
4 forty per centum (40%) of the salaries, which may be paid to June thirtieth
5 in any year to the judges of the County Court in any county by reason of the
6 provisions of this act, shall be refunded to said county by the State Treasurer
7 on warrant of the Director of the Division of Budget and Accounting in the**

8 Department of the Treasury on vouchers certified or approved by the county
9 treasurer and the Administrative Director of the Courts.

1 4. Section 2:6-16 of the Revised Statutes is repealed. In addition, all
2 acts and parts of acts inconsistent with any of the provisions of this act are
3 to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

1 5. As to each judge of a County Court in office on the effective date of
2 this act, the salaries provided herein shall be retroactive to the first day of
3 January, one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine—the additional com-
4 pensation, if any, provided by this act to which such judge shall be entitled
5 for the period from January first, one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine,
6 to the effective date of this act to be paid to him by the county within one
7 month after this act takes effect.

1 6. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

County Court judges in Essex, Hudson, Bergen, Union, Passaic, Camden, Middlesex, Mercer, Monmouth and Atlantic counties will come within the provisions of Section 1 of the bill.

County Court judges in Morris, and Burlington counties will come within the provisions of Section 2 (a) of the bill.

County Court judges in Somerset, Cumberland, Gloucester, Warren, Salem, Ocean, Hunterdon, Sussex and Cape May counties will come within the provisions of Section 2 (b) of the bill.

An Act concerning salaries of judges of the County Courts, and repealing section 2:6-16 of the Revised Statutes.

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New

Jersey:

1. The annual salary of each judge of a County Court, in and for a county in which the Governor may appoint more than one judge of the County Court, shall be sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000.00).

2. The annual salary of each judge of a County Court, in and for a county in which the Governor may appoint only one judge of the County Court, shall be:

(a) In counties having more than seventy-five thousand inhabitants, ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00).

(b) In counties having not more than seventy-five thousand inhabitants, seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500.00).

3. The salaries of the judges of the several County Courts provided herein shall be payable from county funds, by the treasurers of the respective counties, in equal semimonthly installments; provided, however, that forty per centum (40%) of the salaries, which may be paid to June thirtieth in any year to the judges of the County Court in any county by reason of the provisions of this act, shall be refunded to said county by the State Treasurer on warrant of the Director of the Division of Budget and Accounting in the

8 Department of the Treasury on vouchers certified or approved by the county
9 treasurer and the Administrative Director of the Courts.

1 4. Section 2:6-16 of the Revised Statutes is repealed. In addition, all
2 acts and parts of acts inconsistent with any of the provisions of this act are,
3 to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

1 5. As to each judge of a County Court in office on the effective date of
2 this act, the salaries provided herein shall be retroactive to the first day of
3 January, one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine—the additional com-
4 pensation, if any, provided by this act to which such judge shall be entitled
5 for the period from January first, one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine,
6 to the effective date of this act to be paid to him by the county within one
7 month after this act takes effect.

1 6. This act shall take effect immediately.
