AN ACT concerning coastal resources, amending P. L. 1970, c. 33 and P. L. 1948, c. 448, supplementing Title 13 of the Revised Statutes, and repealing P. L. 1945, c. 22, s. 29.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 4 of P. L. 1970, c. 33 (C. 13:1D-3) is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 4. a. The Division of **Resource Development** *Marine Services*,
4 together with all of its functions, powers and duties is continued as
5 the Division of **Marine Services** *Coastal Resources* in the Depart-
6 ment of Environmental Protection.

7 b. The **Resource Development** *Natural Resource* Council,
8 together with all of its functions, powers and duties, is continued
9 as the **Natural** *Tidelands* Resource Council in the Department
10 of Environmental Protection. This act shall not affect the terms
11 of office of the present members of the council. The members of the
12 council shall continue to be appointed as provided by existing law.

13 ***[c. No action shall be taken by said council except upon the ap-**
14 *proval of the Commissioner of Environmental Protection. No*
15 *riparian leases or grants shall be made unless approved by a*
16 *majority of the Tidelands Resource Council and signed by its chair-*
17 *man; and no such lease or grant shall be made except when ap-*
18 *proved by the Governor and the Commissioner of Environmental*
19 *Protection.]**

1 2. Section 13 of P. L. 1948, c. 448 (C. 13:1B-13) is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 13. *No action shall be taken by the council except upon the*
4 *approval of the Commissioner of Environmental Protection. No*
5 *riparian leases or grants shall hereafter be allowed except when*
6 *approved by at least a majority of the* **Resource Development**
7 **Council** *council and signed by the chairman of the council; and*

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

8 no such leases or grants shall hereafter in any case be allowed except
9 when approved and signed by the Governor and the Commissioner
10 of **Conservation and Economic Development** *Environmental*
11 *Protection*.

1 3. (New section) a. Whenever the term "Division of Resource
2 Development", "Division of Natural Resources", or "Division of
3 Marine Services" or the terms "Director of the Division of Re-
4 source Development", "Director of the Division of Natural Re-
5 sources", or "Director of the Division of Marine Services" occurs
6 or any reference is made thereto in any law, contract or document,
7 the same shall be deemed to mean or refer to the Division of
8 Coastal Resources and director thereof, respectively.

9 b. Whenever the term "Resource Development Council", "Plan-
10 ning and Development Council" or "Natural Resource Council"
11 occurs on any reference is made thereto in any law, contract or
12 document, the same shall be deemed to mean or refer to the Tide-
13 lands Resource Council.

1 4. Section 29 of P. L. 1945, c. 22 (C. 13:1A-29) is repealed.

1 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
