STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to define more clearly the regulatory powers of the board, to require an optometrist to notify the board of any change in his office address, to enforce ethical and professional practice in the interest of public health and welfare by a new listing of causes for revocation or suspension of licenses, to provide for the issuance of branch office licenses and limiting the number thereof, and to establish as the exclusive property of the examining optometrist his examination records of patients.

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
