AN ACT concerning the sale of lands by boards of education in certain townships, incorporated towns, boroughs and cities, and amending section 18:7-73 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 18:7-73 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
2 18:7-73. With the previous authority of a vote of the legal voters of the
3 district, a board may purchase [, sell] and improve school grounds; erect,
4 lease, enlarge, improve, repair or furnish school buildings and borrow money
5 therefor with or without mortgage. A board of education may sell or dispose
6 of any of its real estate, or rights or interest therein, which cease to be
7 suitable or convenient for the use for which they were acquired or which are
8 no longer needed for school purposes, in the manner set forth in sections
9 18:5-25 to 18:5-29, both inclusive, of this Title.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to make section 18:7-73 (which requires a vote of the voters of the district to authorize the sale or other disposition of real estate) conform with sections 18:5-25 to 18:5-29, inclusive (which are applicable to school districts in general and do not require a vote of the voters of the district to authorize the sale or other disposition of real estate).
