AN ACT concerning the carrying of concealed weapons and amending section
2A:151-43 of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 2A:151-43 of the New Jersey Statutes is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 2A:151-43. Section 2A:151-41 of this Title does not apply to:

4 a. The United States Marshal or his deputies;

5 b. Members of the Armed Forces of the United States or of the national
6 guard when on duty;

7 c. Any sheriff, undersheriff, deputy sheriff, county prosecutor, assistant
8 prosecutor or prosecutor's detective;

9 d. The regularly employed members, including detectives, of the police
10 department of any county or municipality or of any *State, interstate, munic-*
11 *ipal or county park police force or of any county boulevard police force at all*
12 *times, while within the State of New Jersey, or any special policeman ap-*
13 *pointed by the governing body of any county or municipality or by the com-*
14 *mission or other board or body having control of any county park police force*
15 *or any county boulevard police force while engaged in the actual performance*
15A *of his official duties;*

- 16 e. Any member of the State Police, or any motor vehicle inspector or
17 State detective;
- 18 f. Any jailer, constable, railway police, canal or steamboat police, or any
19 other peace officer, when in discharge of his duties;
- 20 g. The fish and game commissioners, or the regular fish and game ward-
21 ens, or full-time employees of the Division of Shell Fisheries having the
22 power of arrest and authorized to carry weapons;
- 23 h. Any prison or jail wardens or their deputies, or any guard or keeper
24 of any penal institution in this State, while engaged in the actual perform-
25 ance of the duties of their positions and when so required by their superior
26 officers to carry firearms;
- 27 i. Any court attendant serving as such under appointment by the sheriff
28 of the county or by the judge of or magistrate of any court of this State;
- 29 j. Any member of a legally organized detective agency;
- 30 k. Any guard in the employ of any railway express company, banking or
31 building and loan or savings and loan institution of this State;
- 32 l. Any officer of the society for the prevention of cruelty to animals;
- 33 m. Any duly authorized military organization when under orders, or
34 any member thereof when going to or from the place of meeting of the organ-
35 ization, carrying the weapons prescribed for drill, exercise or parade;
- 36 n. Persons having a hunter's license in going to or from places of
37 hunting;
- 38 o. Members of government civilian rifle clubs duly organized in accord-
39 ance with the rules prescribed by the national board for the promotion of
40 rifle practice, in going to or from their several places of target practice and
41 carrying weapons necessary for such practice;
- 42 p. The director, deputy directors, inspectors and investigators of the
43 Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control in the Department of Law and Public
44 Safety;
- 45 q. Public utility corporations in the transportation of explosives; or

46 r. Any civil employee of the United States Government under the super-
47 vision of the commanding officer of any post, camp, station, base or other
48 military or naval installation located within this State who is required, in
49 the performance of his official duties, to carry firearms, and who is authorized
50 to carry such firearms by said commanding officer, while such civil employee is
51 engaged in the actual performance of his official duties.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
