AN ACT concerning State aid for mosquito extermination and control and making an appropriation therefor.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. The amount annually appropriated as State aid to counties for mos-
2 quito extermination and control shall be apportioned by the Director of the
3 Division of Budget and Accounting in the Department of the Treasury
4 among the several counties. Each county desiring State aid for this purpose
5 shall on or before the first day of June of each year file with the director by
6 certificate of its county treasurer a statement of the amount appropriated by
7 the county and to be made available during the county's fiscal year for mos-
8 quito extermination and control.

9 The director shall apportion the State aid so that each county shall re-
10 ceive an amount equal to the amount appropriated and to be made available
11 by the county for such purposes. In the event that the total amount appro-
12 priated and to be made available by the several counties in any county fiscal
13 year shall exceed the amount of the State aid appropriation, the apportion-
14 ment to each county shall be made in the proportion that the amount of
15 money appropriated for said purposes by each county for the county's fiscal
16 year bears to the total amount appropriated by all the counties of the State

17 to be ascertained from the certificates of the several county treasurers filed
18 with the director.

1 2. State aid sums shall be paid by warrant of the director drawn on
2 the State Treasurer in favor of the several county treasurers for the use
3 of the county in the program of mosquito extermination and control on or
4 before July fifteenth in each year.

1 3. There is hereby appropriated the sum of one hundred and fifty thou-
2 sand dollars (\$150,000.00) for State aid for mosquito extermination when
3 included in any annual or supplemental appropriation act.

1 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

8 said county.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. The amount annually appropriated as State aid for mosquito ex-
2 termination and control in counties bordering on the Atlantic ocean to the
3 State Department of Health shall be used by the State Commissioner of
4 Health in airplane spraying for mosquito extermination in each of such
5 counties in accordance with the health needs of the respective counties as
6 determined by the State Commissioner of Health, said work to be done in
7 conjunction with the work of the Mosquito Extermination Commission in
8 said county.

1 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Department of Health the
2 sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) to carry out the purposes of this
3 act for the fiscal year 1949-1950.

1 3. This act shall take effect July first, one thousand nine hundred and
2 forty-nine.
