AN ACT concerning motor vehicles and traffic regulations, and amending section 39:4-1 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New  
2 Jersey:

1 1. Section 39:4-1 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

2 39:4-1. The provisions of this chapter applicable to the drivers of vehi-  
3 cles on the highways shall apply to the drivers of all vehicles owned or  
4 operated by this State or a county, municipality or other political sub-  
5 division of the State, subject to such specific exceptions as are set forth in  
6 this chapter.

7 The provisions of this chapter shall apply to the owners and drivers of  
8 vehicles on the highways, including roadways or driveways upon grounds  
9 owned and maintained by the State of New Jersey, or any State department  
10 or agency, the counties, the municipalities and the school district boards of  
11 education of this State.

12 This chapter shall not apply to persons, teams, motor vehicles and  
13 other equipment while actually engaged in work on the surface of a highway,  
14 but shall apply to such persons and vehicles when traveling to or from the  
15 work.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
