AN ACT concerning lotteries and amending sections 2A :121-3 and
2A :170-18 of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

3 1. Section 2A :121-3 of the New Jersey Statutes is amended to
4 read as follows:

5 2A :121-3. Any person who:

6 a. Knowingly engages as a messenger, clerk or copyist, or in any
7 other capacity in or about an office or room in any building or place
8 where lottery slips or copies of numbers or lists of drawings of a
9 lottery, drawn or to be drawn anywhere within or without this
10 State, are printed, kept or used in connection with the business of
11 lottery or lottery policy, so-called; or

12 b. Knowingly possesses any paper, document, slip or memo-
13 randum that pertains in any way to the business of lottery or
14 lottery policy, so-called, whether the drawing has taken place or,
15 not, *except that this subsection shall not apply to any person who*
16 *has in his possession or custody any paper, document, slip or memo-*
17 *randum of a lottery which is authorized, sponsored and operated*
18 *by any State of the United States, provided that the paper, docu-*
19 *ment, slip, or memorandum was purchased by the holder thereof*
20 *in the State wherein such lottery was authorized, sponsored and*
21 *operated; or*

22 c. Being the owner of a building or place where any business of
23 lottery or lottery policy, so-called, is carried on knowingly, by him-
24 self or his agent, permits such premises to be so used is guilty of a
25 misdemeanor.

1 2. Section 2A :170-18 of the New Jersey Statutes is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 2A :170-18. Any person who has in his possession or custody any
4 lottery slips, books or records pertaining to a lottery, or any person
5 who has in his possession or has in an automobile in his custody
6 any ticket or tickets, slip or slips, paper, document or memoranda
7 in any way pertaining to the business of a number game, is a
8 disorderly person. "Number game" as used in this section means
9 any betting on any number or numbers, or sets or arrangements
10 of numbers, on or according to any plan or method whatsoever.

11 *This section shall not apply to any person who has in his posses-*
12 *sion or custody any ticket, slip, paper, document or memorandum*
13 *of a lottery which is authorized, sponsored and operated by any*
14 *State of the United States, provided that the ticket, slip, paper,*
15 *document or memorandum was purchased by the holder thereof in*
16 *the State wherein such lottery was authorized, sponsored and*
17 *operated.*

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
