AN ACT to supplement an act entitled "An act concerning alcoholic beverages,"
passed December sixth, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Any person convicted of a crime involving moral turpitude may,
2 after the lapse of ten (10) years from the date of conviction, apply to the
3 State Commissioner of Alcoholic Beverage Control for an order removing
4 the resulting statutory disqualification from obtaining or holding any license
5 or permit under the act, as amended and supplemented, to which this is a
6 supplement.

1 2. Whenever any such application is made and it appears to the satisfac-
2 tion of the commissioner that at least ten (10) years have elapsed from the
3 date of conviction, that the applicant has conducted himself in a law-
4 abiding manner during that period and that his association with the alcoholic
5 beverage industry will not be contrary to the public interest, the commis-
6 sioner may, in his discretion and subject to rules and regulations, enter an
7 order removing the applicant's disqualification from obtaining or holding a
8 license or permit because of the conviction.

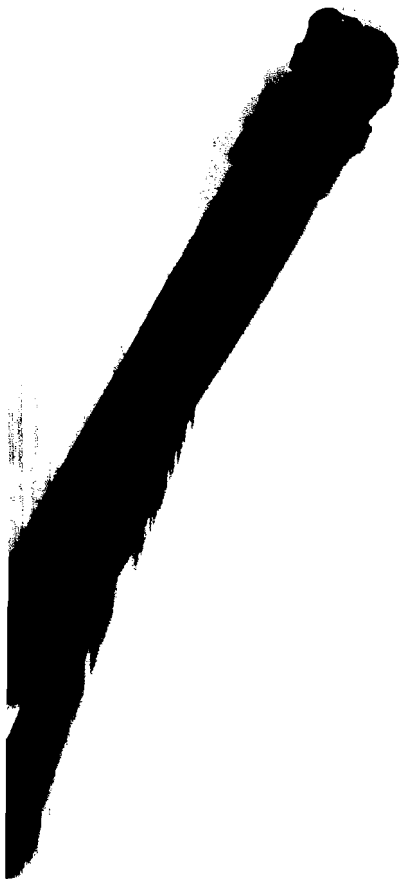
1 3. On and after the date of the entry of such order, the person therein
2 named shall be qualified to obtain and hold a license or permit under the
3 act, as amended and supplemented, to which this is a supplement, notwith-

4 standing the conviction therein referred to, provided he is, in all other
5 respects, qualified under said act.

1 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

To enable a person who has been convicted of a crime involving moral turpitude to obtain a license or permit under the control act where it appears to the satisfaction of the commissioner that ten years have elapsed since the date of the conviction, that he has conducted himself properly during that period and that the public interest will not be endangered by his association with the alcoholic beverage industry.
